HOW TO GIVE DURING COVID-19

- Pre-Authorized Debit through your bank. Call the church office for a form or go to weyburnfmc.com/give. Complete and print the fill-able PDF form there and put it in the Drop-Box at the church.
- E-Transfer: Please contact the bookkeeper at wfmcbkbookkeeper@weyburnfmc.com for the necessary codes.
- Weyburn Credit Union members may add WFMC as a payee and give in your payments menu (Please contact the bookkeeper at wfmcbkbookkeeper@weyburnfmc.com for a code).
- Cheques may be left in the Drop-Box at the south Parking Lot door of the church. **NO CASH!**
- A locked offering box will be available both as you enter and following services.
