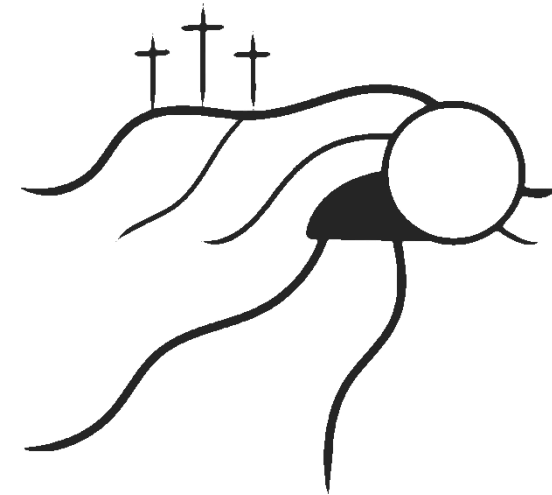

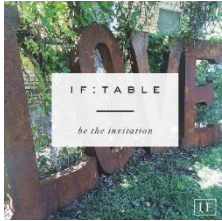

## HAITI ARISE UPDATE

Here is an update about Haiti and Haiti ARISE and our situation..... In mid-February, we were air evacuated out of the Haiti ARISE campus to the airport in Port au Prince. The country was having very major demonstrations and all of the major highways were shut down. Communications were starting to disintegrate and supplies were running very short. We are back here in Weyburn waiting for the 'do not travel' advisory to be lifted for Haiti. This advisory affects our ability to get travel insurance. The team schedule has been reset to extend into the summer and to start up earlier in the fall.

Please pray for Haiti..... the people there are struggling with getting the basics of life although it is settling. In our area, school has resumed, and our medical clinic is open, as are gas stations, etc.

So, we are in a waiting period and hope to be returning soon.
