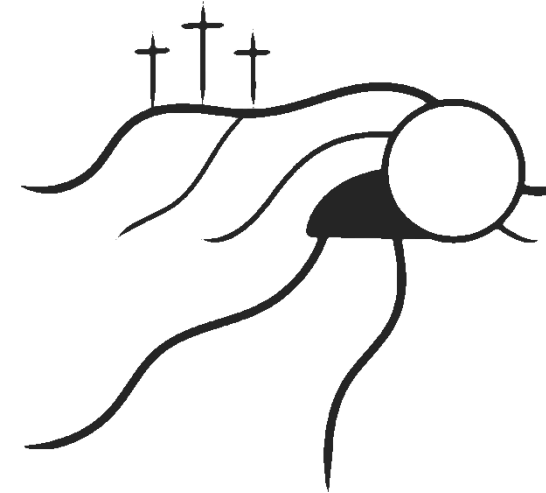

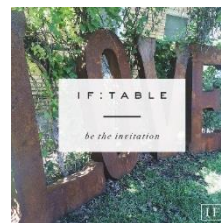

- A delicious meal for our IF:Table to share together.

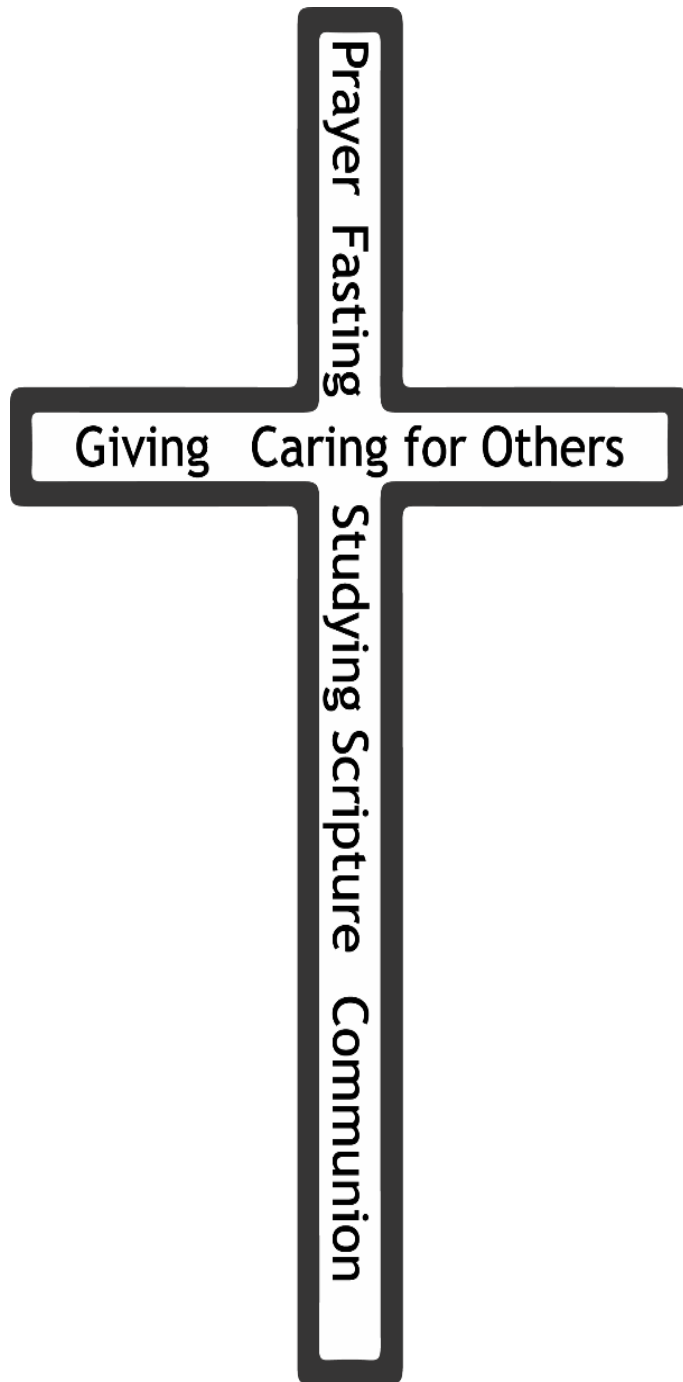
