In-Person Services: Begin on **Saturday, September 12th at 6 pm** and **Sunday, September 13th at 11 am**. See announcement below for more details.

Live Stream: Our 11 am service is live-streamed each Sunday at weyburnfmc.com/live (on both Facebook Live and Youtube). Live-streaming will continue once in-person services begin, but will look a little different with the live audience.

In-Person Church

Saturdays at 6:00 pm and Sundays at 11:00 am

The Board and Pastors met to discuss the future of our in-person gatherings as a church body and tasked our Lead Pastors with leading our church forward so that we can resume in-person gatherings in a safe and responsible way.

We plan on having three Phases to 're-opening' our in-person services (no dates for Phases 2 and 3 yet):

PHASE 1: Socially distanced seating, immediate family groups only, no children's ministry - begins September 13. Live-streaming of the 11:00 Sunday Service will continue, though it will look different with an in-person service.

PHASE 2: Socially distanced seating, registered cohort groups can sit together, no children's ministry.

PHASE 3: Add children's ministry programming (format TBD)

Service registration will be very important for ensuring we have an accurate record of our attendance (Register [HERE](#)). We are required to keep these records in case we need to assist in contact tracing. This will also be very important to ensure we do not exceed our capacity and have to turn people away. If a service is getting full, please consider an alternative service time so that we do not exceed the capacity of our sanctuary.

Helplessness &
Hopefulness
Thursday, Sept. 17,
2020 (7:00-8:45 pm)**

The heart of prayer that changes things requires a God-given balance between helplessness and hopefulness. Helplessness without hope breeds doubt and despair. Hopefulness without helplessness breeds false confidence in human plans and efforts. In this session we will learn how to cultivate both in ourselves and our churches.

During this time Doug and Margie Newton will continue to teach us about how we can grow our own prayer lives, and develop our churches and movement into a “House of Prayer”. This in turn will invite a fresh outpouring of the holy spirit upon us and through us. The couple doing the teaching initiated the formation of the National Prayer Ministry of the Free Methodist Church in the United States. They come with great hearts of prayer and experience in teaching pastoral couples and churches how to pray. Here is a quote from them:
