Hello from the Fitzpatrick's in Weyburn,

We arrived back late May after compressing our late season teams and individuals. The year ended very well considering the challenges we had in the spring with civil unrest within the country. It resulted in an emergency helicopter evacuation in February.

Your prayers, emails and visits with us through this time were most appreciated. It truly felt that we are partners in this ministry.

Some of the highlights from this year at Haiti ARISE area are:

- ✚ Work continued on the third duplex at the Children's Village – painting, tiling, electrical, and plumbing
- ✚ A new couple moved into the Children's Village and shortly after received three young sisters
- ✚ Two week medical team from BC
- ✚ A team built a church shelter for our church plant in the south -- Hurricane Matthew area
- ✚ The birthing center was begun and Haiti ARISE was able to get a great deal of work done on it
- ✚ A team from Alberta hosted a women's conference with 100 women in leadership from our church and churches from our fellowship
- ✚ The Education team did a fall and a spring update on the students (approximately 700 from preschool to university)
- ✚ A major food distribution for our area and many churches that are a part of our network outside of our area – feeding approximately 1,500 families
- ✚ An auto body shop was begun and work continues on it
- ✚ A team of engineering students from University of Calgary taught auto Cad in the Technical school for two days
