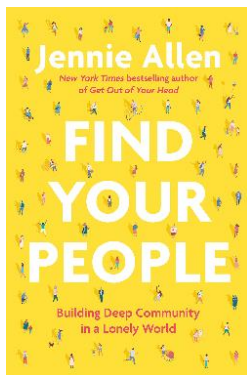

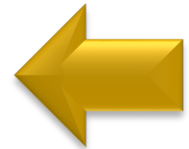

 - **E-Transfer:** Please contact the bookkeeper at wfmcbkkeeper@weyburnfmc.com for the necessary codes.
 - Weyburn Credit Union members may add WFMC as a payee and give in your payments menu (Please contact the bookkeeper at wfmcbkkeeper@weyburnfmc.com for a code).
 - **Cheques** may be left in the Drop-Box at the south Parking Lot door of the church. **NO CASH!**
